Teacher Interviews - Mrs Lee!

Mrs Lee is an English teacher and Leo tutor who runs two amazing clubs at Lynn Grove: Debate Society on Wednesday lunchtimes alongside Miss Bridges, and Creative Writing Club on Fridays after school. These clubs were set up in response to pupil requests and give pupils the chance to explore debating and creative writing, which there isn't always time for in lessons. The groups are relaxed and often focus on topics pupils are most interested in.

Mrs Lee also runs writing competitions every half term. At the time of the interview, she was holding a winter story competition, alongside others throughout the year, including poetry and comedy. By varying the styles and genres, she encourages as many students as possible to get involved and write about what interests them.

Mrs Lee says she is very proud to be a teacher at Lynn Grove and believes it is a school that really looks after its community, despite some of the challenges. She values being part of a school that offers so many opportunities to children and is proud of what staff can provide for pupils.
