<b>Unit 2 Coursework Unit Autumn -Spring  Year 11</b>	Music Product:	In this Unit pupils will plan, develop and deliver a music product- a lunchtime concert. They will promote the concert and review the management of it.	This unit is assessed internally and externally verified by Pearson.
<b>Unit 5 Spring- Summer Year 11</b>	Performance	Pupils will develop their music performance skills and review their own practice. They will use their music performance skills within rehearsals and performance.	This unit is assessed internally and externally verified by Pearson.
